
Learning Objective:-

To a large degree, the sweet experience of visitors depends on the availability and quality of good tourist facilities. The provision of support services and the provision of quality tourism services can lead to tourist satisfaction.

Tamil Nadu is a lovely place with an enormous number of tourist centers. Yet, significant numbers of tourists remain unidentified in these tourist centers. Nature themes in this district relate in a modest way to the flora, fauna, parks, scenic beauty, geology, and marine environment available Besides cultural themes, traditional lifestyles are also available here including music, dance, fine arts, drama, architecture, crafts and archaeology. Competition and creativity in



advertising campaigns is the most critical issue in the tourism industry. The tourist attractions and facilities are not very successful. It is important to fix the following aspects of the problems with waste disposal, cleanliness in public areas, lack of tourist guides, lack of work opportunities, lack of transport facilities and poor accommodation within the tourist location.
