THEME: Indian Culture and Tradition – Rajasthan

India is a land of diverse culture and tradition. The state of Rajasthan has a rich and unique heritage of art and culture which is recognized and treasured across the globe. Its unique charm is reflected in its architecture, costumes, cuisine and art and craft. Let us delve deep into the culture and tradition of Rajasthan and enrich ourselves.

<u>WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:</u> The class will be divided into 5 groups. Each group will create a brochure as mentioned below.

Imagine that your school has arranged for a **cultural exchange programme** with the colourful state of Rajasthan. The fest will be held for 3 days, where artists from Rajasthan will come and showcase their skills. The third day will be a celebration of the fusion of the cuisine of Rajasthan and your state with stalls of the unique Sheherwali cuisine of the Oswal Jain Community merchants who migrated to Bengal from the deserts of Rajasthan. Refer to the links provided to gather information about the different aspects of Rajasthan required for your project.

The schedule of the fest will be as follows-

- Day 1: Music and dance performance of artists from Rajasthan
- Day 2: Exhibition of textiles and handicrafts of Rajasthan by artisans of that state
- Day 3: Food stalls of the Sheherwali cuisine

Brochure Designing: A brochure is a small booklet or pamphlet, especially one that contains pictures and is used for advertising purposes. Design a brochure giving information about the above mentioned fest which will be held in your school.

Your brochure must include the following:

- Cover page Give an interesting name to the fest and provide other necessary details. Draw elements of both the states of Rajasthan and West Bengal to decorate the page.
- > An introduction about the aim of the fest.
- ➤ The venue, dates and timings of the programme to be mentioned.
- > Day wise schedule along with relevant details to be given. Give a separate title for each day.
- For day 1: Mention the names of the artists with a few lines about the art forms that they will present.
- For day 2: Names and a few lines on the things that will be exhibited to be given.
- For day 3: What is Sheherwali cuisine and how did it evolve? How has it been influenced by the cuisine of West Bengal. Name a few items that will be available in the stalls.
- Last page: Look for items in your house that belong to Rajasthan and West Bengal. The items may have been bought or made by you. Arrange them artistically, click a picture and paste it on the last page of the brochure.
- Include suitable drawings/pictures on all the pages to enhance your overall presentation.


- make a comparative study of the state of West Bengal and Rajasthan

Sreemoyee, a nine year old girl from West Bengal, will visit Rajasthan along with her parents and grandparents during the Summer Vacation. Sreemoyee read the story "Sonar Kella" and being inspired by Feluda (the famous detective) made a thorough research of Rajasthan before visiting that place and made a comparative study with her residing state, West Bengal.









- 1. Few questions will be given to answer based on the above data on the day of the project.
- 2. Since Sreemoyee lives in the coastal area of West Bengal she noticed a sharp contrast in climate, food, clothing, festivals, language, art and craft of Rajasthan which is an arid or semi-arid desert. Let us discuss about few of her observations.

Rajasthan is the most water deficient state in the country following short spell of monsoon coupled with erratic behaviour and scanty rainfall. Lack of surface water and a weak monsoon creates water scarcity during the summers every year. Determined to pull themselves out of their predicament, the women have formed 'water committees' and revived traditional methods of water harvesting. Women have brought up potable water to their doorstep using conventional techniques. Over the years, the people of Rajasthan, have devised several ways of saving water.

The Project is to be done in groups, with the above information and a little research on your own:

Your group has been recently sent to Jodhpur district in Rajasthan as a representative of the Water Department of Rajasthan Government, to help the people in conserving water. Your group has been given the responsibility of encouraging the people of the village to construct rooftop tanks to conserve the rainwater by harvesting it.

Q1. Make a model of a rooftop water harvesting device where the rainwater will be stored for domestic use. You can use old shoe boxes, cartons, used paper cups, straws, and unused materials in your home to construct the same. You can use your own creativity to improvise and design your own rooftop model.

Add on modules like Mobile app, reality check module, GIS integration and applications like data analytics have been developed and implemented for enhanced experienced reality check under module with automatic speech recognition ASR functionality has been integrated with Rajasthan Sampark portal

A new toll free number 181 for the CM helpline has been activated e-Sakhi

Free digital training provided to 1.5 Lakh women through e Sakhi program to bridge the digital divide between the residents and various state government schemes. these volunteers or Sakhi further train people from their respective village or urban areas to access digital service connecting maximum citizen in the state and ensuring that at least one person from every rural family is made digitally literate.

Rajasthan digikit

digital kit is provided to all residents to equip them with basic services and enable them to avail the services of the government digitally

digikit includes facilities such as single sign on, Raj e sign, Raj e-Sign, Raj mail in Hindi and other programs

E-Mitra Plus

presently more than 500 services of government / private organisations are being provided electronically through more than 55.250 e-mitra Kiosks to the citizens of the state. it is a revolutionary step ahead in E Service Delivery. it provides the services directly without any human interface just as ATM does. it is the first of its kind in India One can apply for government documents like birth certificate, domicile certificate and get print through inbuilt printer. it allows multiple payment modes such as cash debit or credit card, net banking.

Hindi e-mail

Rajasthan is the first and only residents. Rajasthan has become the first state in the country to offer free e-mail address in Hindi to its residents. The facility —name@rajasthan.bharat (in Devanagari script) — will lead to millions of new users who are not comfortable with English e-mail ids, officials said.

Raj e-Gyan

For improving education in the state, the state's ICT department has conceptualised Raj e-Gyan, which provides easy access to ubiquitous, updated and extensive repository of digital content to students. Through online e-learning content, the state government has been able to spread education in the most remote corner of Rajasthan.

RajBOT

The project has been envisaged for establishment of a platform for engagement of the citizens with the state government, by improving the speed and effectiveness of the interaction. To enhance the citizens' experience in interaction with the government, Robots are being trained to mimick human cinversation, for interactive and intuitive communication with citizens in real time.


